The Women's Concern Network is seeking new members from the Wayne County area. Network meetings are held in-person twice a year and at other times through conference calls- usually around 3 pm on week days. Community projects require a time commitment of a few hours at various times during the year.

The Women's Concern Network provides breast health information and updates to providers and interested individuals in Summit, Portage, Stark, and Wayne Counties. Goals include increasing breast health awareness, increasing mammography screening rates, reducing late stage diagnosis, and reducing mortality rates for breast cancer and thus, saving lives.
